Your child may have come home from school on Wednesday and told you all about Quilliam, the little hedgehog we rescued from the school playing field at lunch time. We suspect Quilliam had not long woken up from hibernation and from our knowledge we thought it was unusual for a hedgehog to be out at this time of day. We carefully picked him up, gave him some water which he enjoyed and put warm water in a bottle to keep him warm—which he snuggled up to. We called Trindledown Farm for advice and they recommended we call The Oxford Wildlife Rescue Team based in Blewbury. The team there sent out an animal ambulance and Rachael, one of the volunteers, came to collect him to be checked over and cared for. We hope to see him back for a safe and happy release in our school field soon.
