This term we will be learning to...

Phonics and Reading

Year 2 – We will be covering the following spelling rules and patterns:

- Polysyllabic words with Phase 5 sounds.
- Strategies for learning spellings
- Homophones
- Proof reading
- Common exception words

Year 1- Children will be following Phases 4 and 5 of our phonics scheme "A Flying Start". You will be aware of the sounds covered each week through your child's spellings that they will bring home each week.

English Writing

Year 2 – These children will focus on story writing with the following texts:

- Alfie's Star
- How To Catch A Star

We will also learn how to write a set of instructions.

Year 1 - Writing will be in their focussed phonics lessons learning to write with the sounds already known, and being learnt.

<u>Maths</u>

- **Year 1** Focus on place value, addition and subtraction within 10, weight (heavier and lighter) and capacity (full and empty).
- Year 2 Focus on place value, addition and subtraction using numbers up to 100, describing the properties of 2D and 3D shapes and basic symmetry.

Religious Education (RE)

Key Question

Focus of Study

We will be discussing and looking at different special events celebrated in religions. We will also be exploring Judaism and exploring why the Sabbath is important.

Science
