Key Question

- 'Does wisdom look the same for every Christian?'

Focus of Study

We will be able to identify the wisdom literature in the Bible.

We will be able to name and retell some parables from the Bible and suggest the wisdom that Christians take from them.

We will be able to explain how Christians interpret the parables of Jesus in different ways.

We will be able to evaluate Biblical wisdom and compare it to worldly wisdom.

Science – Forces & Working Scientifically
