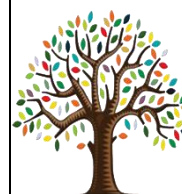

This term we will be learning to...

Phonics and Reading

Year 2 – follow spelling rules and patterns:

- Common exception words.
- “d”, “dge” and “g”
- “s” sound spelt as “c”
- “kn” and “gn”

Year 1- Phases 5 of our phonics scheme “A Flying Start”. There will be a focus on alternative vowel sounds.

English writing

Year 2

- Write our own poems based on “Woolly Saucepan” by Michael Rosen.
- Write a set of instructions.
- Write a re-count linked with our class visit.

Year 1 - Writing will be covered in their phonics lessons and grammar lessons.

Maths

- **Year 1** – addition and subtraction within 10, naming 2D and 3D shapes and capacity (full and empty).
 - **Year 2** – addition and subtraction using numbers up to 100, measuring in metres and centimetres and measuring mass in grams and kilograms.

Focus of Study

- The birth of Jesus in the gospels.

Science

- Everyday Materials- learning to;
 - distinguish between an object and the material from which it is made
 - identify and name a variety of everyday materials, including wood, plastic, glass, metal, water, and rock
- **Key vocabulary:** material, transparent, translucent, opaque, flexible, rigid, reflective

Topic - History

- The Victorians
 - **Key vocabulary:** Queen Victoria, Victorian, Steam Engine, abacus, chalk and butler.

Computing

We will be having a focus on creating digital art.

We will also be thinking about the following areas of internet safety:

- That there are people online who can make us feel unsafe and what we should do if people make us feel sad, frightened, worried or uncomfortable when we are online.
- Asking for permission to do something online and why this is important.
- Using the internet with adult support to communicate with people the children know.
- The importance of treating people kindly online.

Design & Technology
