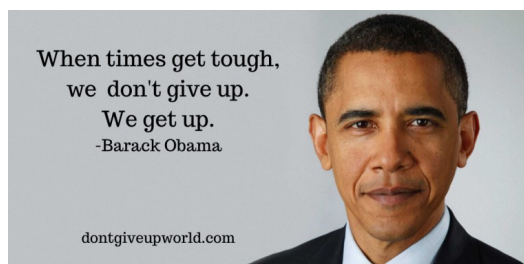

Information about school routines

Breakfast Club—Breakfast is served between 7.30am and 8.00am. If your child arrives after this time, they can attend the club (if booked in) but breakfast will not be available.

Drop off and pick up—No cars on site at these times. If someone different is collecting your child, please also let them know this. In exceptional circumstances, permission will be given for a car to drive on site. Please make a request through the office.

Dogs on site—No dogs beyond the first main gate and if tying your dog up to the fence outside the school, please use the far fence by the bin area.

Registration—All children need to be in school by 8.45am.

Schoolcomms— Please make sure your notifications are switched on for your school gateway app.

Absence—If your child is a little 'under the weather', please let us know but do send them into school if you think they will cope with a school day. We will contact you if they need to go home. If your child is unwell with sickness or diarrhea, please keep them at home until **48 hours** after the final bout. If you are unsure about whether to send your child in because they are unwell, please give us a ring. Please ring the office to inform school of an absence **before 8.45am**.

Concussion—please let us know if your child has had a concussion so that we can monitor them while in school. If a child has a concussion, they will not be able to participate in PE or sporting activities for 14 days unless a doctor has given written consent.
