Introducing Rascal

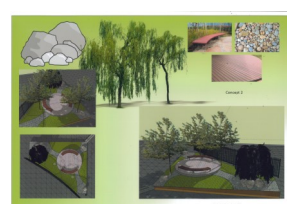

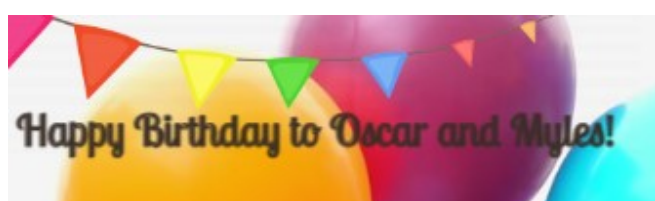
